

To get started with SPC Connect on the web, go to the SPC Connect web interface (<https://www.spconnect.com>) then:


1. Create an account with SPC Connect:
 - a. Click **Register as System User**.
 - b. Enter your details, enter the Captcha code displayed, then click **Register Account**.
 - c. Click the confirmation link in the activation email sent to the email address provided during registration.
2. Log in using your registered username and password.
3. Register your panel(s):
 - a. Go to the **Panels** page.
 - b. In the **Register a Panel to your Account** area, enter the **Panel Registration ID**, **Panel Username** and **Panel Password** provided to you by your panel installer.
 - c. Click **Add Panel to Account**.

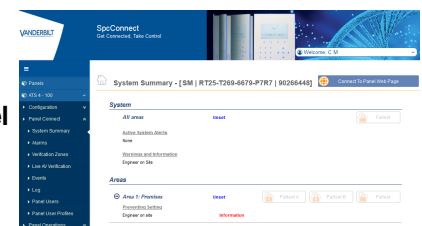

4. View and manage your panel(s):
 - a. Go to the **Panels** page and click **Connect**  for the panel you want to manage.
 - b. On the **Panel Connect** page, view panel information and perform panel management tasks under **System Summary**, **Alarms**, **Events**, **Log**, **Panel Users**, **Panel User Profiles**, **Live Video**, and **Archived Audio Video**. Note that which functions are available depend on how your panel is configured.
 - c. Click buttons on the **System Summary** page to **Unset**, **Partset A**, **Partset B**, or **Fullset** each area.
